What To Expect On The Big Night


- All members and adherents of the congregation will be invited.

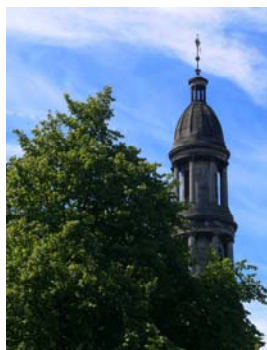
The pledge card can be completed privately and allows each of us to commit ourselves to the planned and faithful giving on which this project depends.
